Bingham Car Parking

Thank you for your letter of 27th November 2008 and Ms Harley's letter of 12th December 2008.

Unfortunately these have not answered the points raised in our letter dated 6th November 2008. These are:

1. We have received an acknowledgement but no response to the proposals we made to your Parking Panel in January. These proposals were supported by 1,600 petition signatures and gave practical suggestions to resolve most of the parking problems.
Your proposals for Bingham do not address the real issues.
2. By implementing Civil Parking Enforcement without taking preventative measures to prevent parking creep into residential areas you have caused misery for many residents.

You say that you will review the position in June next year. The consequences of your actions are plain to see and no new factors are likely to emerge so why not take immediate action?

You are treating your Council Tax payers with contempt.

Will you please follow up our recommendations?
